5. **Covid Recovery Plan – ABUHB**
Members were presented with information regarding the Integrated Wellbeing Network programme from the public health team at ABUHB. Members were advised that the programme is already running successfully in Blaenavon and the team are ready to rollout the programme within Croesyceiliog and Llanyrafon. The aim of the programme is to work co-productively with residents and organisations in the area. This will facilitate opportunities to develop wellbeing for all ages in the community through place-based community hubs such

as GP surgeries and community centres, which Hwb at Woodland Road have already been working towards, in the hope of reducing the need for high level health services. Although the programme is running successfully in Blaenavon it will be adapted by the community through conversation and collaboration to best develop the programme within Croesyceiliog and Llanyrafon. The employment of a new Community Involvement Officer together with a recovery plan will help drive the programme.

6. Identification of sites for planting of trees & wild flowers

Members agreed to bring ideas and identify sites at the next BP meeting. Potential sites identified included

- A Cherry tree on the grassy area at the bottom of Garw Green
- A series of cherry trees on the left at the bottom of Edlogan Way
- Woodland Road
- A cherry tree opposite Blush at Edlogan Square to replace a tree that is due to be felled
- A tree at Holly Lodge Road to replace a felled tree
- Bulb planting at the green areas near the Church of Latter-day Saints and including the grass area between the church and the footpath through to A4042 opposite the Springfield estate.
- Two oak trees together with two trees advised by TCBC to replace large fallen tree on The Highway green
- Bulb planting at the start and along the three main routes into the area, namely Llanfrechfa Way, The Highway, Turnpike/Woodland Road – TCBC could also consider tree planting across these roads as discussed with at site meeting
