## 3. <u>Minutes of Business Planning Committee Meeting 9<sup>th</sup> December 2020</u>

Members received and considered the Minutes of the BPC Meeting 9<sup>th</sup> December 2020. **RESOLVED:** Members approved the Minutes as an accurate record .

#### 5. Refurbishment of Woodland Road

Dan Oliver outlined the works proposed:

- 2021 , tennis courts , submission of funding bid
- Subject to award of funding

2022-2025 – external cladding, lift, reception, enclose tunnel, create volunteer portal 2026 – solar panels on roof 2027-28 – offices & meeting rooms

He explained that planned works were in response to the extensive consultation exercise undertaken.

When asked about the future location for meetings of the Council & the CLCC office it was explained that it would be sometime before decisions will need to be taken & the Council will be fully involved in discussions .

Dan will provide a timeline for submission of funding bid & anticipated decision & this will determine when Dan will next attend Business Planning .

#### 7. Review of project plan

The project plan was discussed.

- It was agreed that TCBC should be asked to place a community bench at Edlogan shops, in the vicinity of the CLCC noticeboard, given residents are currently being required to queue. ( A budget of £1000 was agreed )
- Croesyceliog RFC are to be asked for an update in relation to the development of the new changing rooms, to be considered at the February meeting
- Hwb are to be asked about timescales to transfer the utility contracts
- Cllr Price to be asked about fixing plagues to community benches
- Clerk to find out whether buses still stop at the concrete bus shelters on the Highway
- Hanging baskets to be purchased for WRSSC
- Street Poppies to be purchased in advance of Remembrance Day
- Boating Lake proposals, update to be sought
- Residents views to be sought on tree planting at identified locations
