#### 5. New Changing Rooms at Woodland Road

An update on the planning application was received .

"The building has been moved 4 metres towards the river as it needs to have storm drains running under the old proposed site. The plans have been resubmitted. An emergency flood evacuation plan is being written.

It is anticipated planning permission will be agreed by mid November "

# 6. Wood on Edlogan Way

Lydia Parry Community Interventions Manager at Bron Afon outlined the role of her teams & the involvement in community projects

# 7. Street Poppies

# 8. Purchase of Trees

It was agreed to fund:

- 24 cherry trees, £4560
- 26 fruit trees, £616
- And the associated labour and material costs .

TCBC are to be asked to provide a plan showing the locations of the trees.

# 9. Bench at Bus Stop at Rear of Llanyrafon Shops (Opposite 15 Beaumaris Drive)

It was noted that the Consultation ends on the 27/08/21

Awaiting a response from TCBC Highways on agreement to remove bench (16/08/21).

It was agreed to fund the removal costs & ask TCBC to store the bench.
