1. Apologies

3. Minutes of Business Planning Committee Meeting 18th August 2021

Members received and considered the Minutes of the BPC Meeting 18th August 2021. **RESOLVED:** Members approved the Minutes

4. Matters Arising

Nothing additional to matters on the agenda.

5. Changing Rooms at Woodland Road

The funding request from Croesyceiliog RFC was discussed.

The Clerk is to request information from the Hwb on:

- The quote received & other options
- Who will benefit from the new boiler
- What payments it receives from Croesyceiliog RFC

It was agreed to Recommend to Council that the Community Council funds the replacement of the boiler (£5302 + VAT) & the legionella testing work (around £750) , subject to the information requested from the Hwb.

6. Bench at Bus Stop at Rear of Llanyrafon Shops (Opposite 15 Beaumaris Drive) *

The responses received to the Consultation were discussed, together with the views received from departments at TCBC & the report received from the Police (circulated separately).

Cllr Matthews referred to discussion with Cllr G Caron.

The Clerk explained that there had been a further response from Community Safety , who were now in favour of removing the bench .

It was agreed that the bench would be removed, funded by the Community Council.

7. Project Plan

The updated plan was discussed and:

- No further action to be taken in respect of Litter Bin Removed Junction of Dunraven Rd
 <u>Kidwelly Road</u>
- The Clerk was awaiting a response from TCBC on sharing tree planting costs
- Cllr Gauden proposed a grant scheme for shopkeepers who could apply for the installation of hanging baskets. The Clerk will seek the support of TCBC & Bron Afon in relation to the shops they own in Edlogan Square, North Road & Llanyrafon.
- The Hwb would be able to apply to the grant scheme for Woodland Road.
- A request for funding is expected from Llanyrafon Social Centre
- The project undertaken by Llanyrafon AFC is complete & an invitation has been received to the opening event
- Cllr Gauden confirmed Blush have completed installation of the Defibrillator

8. <u>Traffic Survey on The Highway, Croesyceiliog</u>

A meeting had been held with TCBC Highways, attended by Cllr Crick & the Clerk.

Concerns had been expressed about both the speed & volume of traffic .

TCBC are prepared to undertake a traffic survey at a cost of no more than £1000.

It was agreed to fund the cost of the traffic survey .
