5. Changing Rooms at Woodland Road

It was noted that planning permission is expected in November .

6. Bron Afon Community Development Projects

Linda Brooks explained that Bron Afon had initiated a number of projects during the Pandemic . Initially these focused on isolation & those who had lost loved ones . More recently , the focus had moved to residents who had lost confidence through prolonged periods of isolation.

Linda is to circulate details of the current projects .

7. Project Plan

The updated plan was discussed and :

- It was agreed to relocate an Oak Tree kindly donated by Cllr Crick to the green on the Highway at a cost of £200 Cllr Crick to advise the contractor.
- Cllr Crick referred to tree planting to the rear of the Baptist Church. The proposal was agreed In principle & Cllr Crick will advise the Church to make application for funding .
- Cllr's Dewar, Matthews & Rappell to identify locations for additional bins.
- Clerk to chase TCBC about damaged bench which was subsequently removed , half way between Llanyrafon Social Club & first weir .
- Interpretation Board for Boating Lake to be added to the project plan.
- It was agreed the hanging baskets scheme be made available to any shop in Croesyceiliog and Llanyrafon .
- TCBC to be chased about the Traffic Survey on the Highway
- A defibrillator is being ordered for CCYP.
- Steet Poppies, Cllr's Dewar & Crick to provide lamppost numbers
- It was agreed that it was inappropriate to hold a Grants Awards Evening.
- All Council members are to be reminded of the need to identify new projects .
