- Bron Afon to be asked about a joint agreement to replace all trees removed
- TCBC & Bron Afon to be asked about forming a Community Group on tree & flower planting
- TCBC to be asked to identify damaged bins & those smaller bins which need to be replaced by larger bins
- Residents to be asked to identify locations requiring a litter bin
- Cllr Crick to pursue planting of Oak Tree on the Highway green
- TCBC to be asked about planting of wild seeds at the Boating Lake
- Hanging Basket proposal to be put to residents , local shopkeepers & the Hwb
- Richard Lloyd Evans to be contacted about bird boxes
- Conway Terrace residents to confirm financial contribution available for road improvements
- TCBC to be requested to provide price to replace bench on the River Walk
- CCYP defibrillator is awaiting installation date from TCBC
- Pat Bates to be chased about traffic survey on the Highway
- Street Poppies were a success - find out cost of poppy nets
- Woodland Road Memorial Area to be improved once Padel works complete eg rose garden border
