Clerk's Report

Meetings/Events Attended:

05.02.26 – Boundary Review Online Meeting with OVW

The meeting was interesting. There are many other Councils much more affected than we would be with some having 3 CCs amalgamated into 1 larger Council for example. It concentrated on how this should be achieved including amalgamating policies, TUPE of employees, consultations between all the parties involved, guidance on employment implications etc.

It was interesting to note that although some Principal Councils have agreed to help their CCs to carry out any responsibilities they have regarding the changes, there is no obligation for them to do so. Some have agreed to assist, some have said they do not have the spare resources, so the CCs are on their own and must navigate the process themselves.

Some Principal Authorities have submitted their reviews to the Commission, Torfaen included. On checking, it appears that Torfaen submitted its report to the Commission on 2nd December, and the process appears to take around 2-3 months before an order is made if everything goes smoothly, so hopefully there will be news in the next month or so.

Miscellaneous:

Background admin has carried on as normal including:

The telephone box purchase and refurb has been eventful as everyone knows. We are just waiting on the National Grid to remove the live feed from the box before it can be completely dismantled. In the meantime, the panels are being refurbished and we are working with all involved parties to get the box removed safely asap.

Thankfully, National grid has at least made the box safe for now by switching off the live feed, but obviously there are concerns that it is now open to the elements and there is more chance of it being vandalised prior to removal.
