6. Chair's Announcements

6.1 Cllr V Crick:

- Advised Council of a name change for the Church at the top of Chapel Lane in Croesyceiliog. The Church currently known as Ponrthydyrun Chapel is to be renamed Living Hope Church. Cllr Crick has been invited to attend a renaming ceremony due to take place in September.

9. Member Reports – Meetings of Outside Bodies

- Cllr S Matthews – advised Members that following the Friends of Bruchsal AGM, the new Chair was Cllr Rhiannon Bennett of Cwmbran Community Council.
 - Cllr N Davies had attended the OWV Gwent Valleys Committee Meeting and advised that there was a presentation on cost-of-living projects. Some Councils run their own projects dealing with this issue, but he advised the committee this Council supports these initiatives by giving grants to organisations already running such projects in its wards.
 - Cllr N Davies also attended the Mic Morris Trust meeting which discussed the arrangements for the Mic Morris 10K run and gave details of grants awarded. It was noted a local kick boxer had been awarded a grant by the trust.
 - Cllr C Crick advised Croesyceiliog School gave a farewell show for its leaving Head, which went very well.

10. Items for Consideration

10.1 Woodland Rd Memorial Maintenance

Council discussed the contents of an email received regarding the upkeep of the memorial, which criticised the choice of the tree specimen chosen. Council were disappointed with the comments and the Clerk was asked to respond stating that Council sought horticultural advice on the appropriate specimen tree to plant, and that the recommended Pillar Oak planted is yet to mature and become the statement tree it should in the future, but much care was taken to ensure it will become a fitting tribute.

10.2 Various Planters Maintenance

It was noted that the planters at the Woodland Road Memorial Site are to be replaced soon. It was also recognised how difficult it is to encourage volunteers to help care for the planters in the wards once they are planted up. This issue will be revisited at a future Business Planning meeting.

10.3 Manning a table at The Summer Event

Cllrs C Crick, V Crick and N Davies agreed to man a table at the forthcoming Summer Event held at Woodland Road Centre on 7th August 2026 to promote the works of the Council and ask residents to make suggestions for future projects they would like Council to consider.
